



ILGISA REGIONAL MEETING: Chicago

Monday, May 20, 2024

Meeting Location:

DePaul Center
1 E. Jackson Blvd.
Chicago, IL 60604
8th Floor Conference Center

The DePaul Center building is located between Jackson Blvd. and Van Buren Street along the east side of State Street. There are three building entrances:

- Jackson Boulevard through the main entrance (through the Barnes and Noble bookstore)
- Van Buren just east of State Street
- State Street just north of Van Buren.

If you enter the DePaul School of Law building (25 E. Jackson, corner of Wabash and Jackson) you should exit and walk over to the DePaul Center/bookstore entrance at Jackson and State.



Building Security Check-in – NEW!

Once you're in the building, proceed to the security check-in desk to access the elevators. The elevators to the 8th Floor are located just south of the Barnes & Noble bookstore on the north end of the building. Security staff will ask you to show a photo ID and let them know you are attending the ILGISA Chicago Regional Meeting on the 8th floor.

Getting to the meeting

Public Transportation is strongly recommended: Why drive when you can sit back and read on the train or bus into the Loop?

Chicago Transit Authority - check fares, maps & more at transitchicago.com.

CTA Train Take the Blue Line train to the Jackson underground stop and walk up to street level and then 1 block east on Jackson to the DePaul Center building entrance at 1 E. Jackson. Or take the Orange/Green/Pink/Purple/Brown line trains to the Adams/Wabash or Library stop. From the Adams station, exit down the stairs to Wabash Street and walk south one block to Jackson and turn right and walk west one block to 1 E. Jackson. From the Library station, exit down the east stairs to State Street and walk across the street to the DePaul building entrance at 8 E. Van Buren. Or take the Red Line train to the Jackson underground stop and walk up to street level right at the DePaul Center building entrance at 333 S. State Street.

CTA Bus The #29 State Street bus stops at State and Van Buren and the #1, #7 and #126 buses will deliver you to the corner of Jackson and Wabash. Walk one block back to the DePaul Center entrance at 1 E. Jackson Blvd. There are numerous other bus routes that get you within 2-3 blocks of the meeting.

Metra - check fares, routes, schedules and maps at metrarail.com.

Metra and Amtrak lines arriving at Union Station

Walk south on Canal to the southwest corner of Canal and Jackson. Take the #7 or #126 CTA bus heading east down Jackson. Exit at the State/Jackson bus stop. Cross the street to the DePaul Center entrance at 1 E. Jackson Blvd.

Metra lines arriving at Ogilvie Transportation Center

Walk three blocks south on Canal Street to Jackson Street and take the #7 or #126 CTA bus heading east down Jackson. Exit at the State/Jackson bus stop. Cross the street to the DePaul Center entrance at 1 E. Jackson Blvd.

Metra lines arriving at Van Buren Street station

Walk three blocks west on Van Buren Street almost to State Street and then enter the DePaul Center at 8 E. Van Buren St. Walk north through the lobby to the elevators next to the Barnes and Noble bookstore.

Metra lines arriving at LaSalle Street Station

Walk ½ block north to Van Buren Street and then turn right and walk 2 blocks east to the DePaul Center at 8 E. Van Buren St. Walk north through the lobby to the elevators.

Driving:

Driving into the Loop requires skill and patience. Make sure to check traffic the morning of the meeting before choosing your route and take extra time. The Kennedy expressway has major construction from Irving Park into downtown, for example. Depending on traffic, I-90/94 (Kennedy & Dan Ryan Expressways) & I-290 (Eisenhower Expressway) on the west, I-55 (Stevenson Expressway) on the south, or Lake Shore Drive on the east can all lead you to the Loop.

Parking:

There are several pay lots and garages within 1-2 blocks of DePaul Center. The closest are on Wabash Street between Adams Street and Harrison Street and the day rates range from \$20 - \$28. *Tip: The farther south you go on Wabash, the cheaper the day rate. Arrive before 9:00am for the Earlybird day rates. You can also check these apps ([iParkit](#), [SpotHero](#) or [ParkWhiz](#)) for cheaper parking rates nearby.*
