Bloomington is home to the nationally accredited, award-winning, not-for-profit McLean County Museum of History. The museum's collections include 20,000 cataloged objects and more than 1,700 linear feet of archival material. Join Museum Librarian Bill Kemp and Archivist George Perkins for a behind-the-scenes tour of the archives, library reading room, and exhibits, with an emphasis on the museum's expansive map collection. Participants will also be able to stop by the "Crusin' with Lincoln on 66" visitors center and gift shop which celebrates Bloomington-Normal's deep connections to both U.S. Route 66 and Abraham Lincoln.
